- e. Cost is approximately \$1800
- f. Offers practice monitoring

Ethics and Boundaries Assessment Services (EBAS)

- b. The essay examination assesses the examinee’s understanding of ethical and boundary issues in the professional workplace environment.
- c. Can apply to many different clinical situations
- d. Results are pass/fail
- e. Cost is approximately \$400

- b. “Maintaining Proper Boundaries” – 3 day in-person course taught by professionals performing research in the field of boundary violations
- c. Intensive self-assessment screening and required interaction/discussion
- d. Focus on education and self-awareness
- e. No pass/fail result
- f. Cost is approximately \$3000

UC San Diego (PACE Program)

- b. Offers courses on Medical Record Keeping, Ethics, Anger Management, and Boundaries
- c. Specialize in assessment and remediation for medical professionals
- d. Offers “pass/fail” assessments
