- Explain the intervention
- · Use simple, non-technical language

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OPTIONS

- Discuss alternative treatments
- · Identify possible providers

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NECESSARY DISCLOSURE

- Share benefits and risks
- Clarify expected outcomes

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SHARED DECISION-MAKING

- · Confirm the patient/client's ability to decide
- Encourage questions and input

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EMPOWER AUTONOMY

- Respect the right to accept or refuse care
- · Consent can be modified or withdrawn at any time

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NURTURE TRUST


- Build a collaborative relationship
- · Establish professional boundaries

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TRANSPARENCY

- Document the consent process clearly
- Review expected timeframes and costs





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
