The road to an operational Compact to increase access to physical therapy services and improve licensure portability for PTs and PTAs:

2010: FSBPT Delegate Assembly requests options for Compact be explored

2013: FSBPT Delegate Assembly motion to support development of a Compact

2014 Apr-Jul: FSBPT Advisory task force meets

2015 Jan-Apr: FSBPT Drafting team meets

2015 Jan-May: PTC draft language completed; public call for comments

2015 Oct: PTC language final

2016: PTC first introduced in state legislatures (AZ, MO, NJ, OR, TN)

Arizona, Missouri, Oregon, and Tennessee sign PTC into law

2017: Colorado, Kentucky, Mississippi, Montana, New Hampshire, North Carolina, North Dakota, Texas, Utah, and Washington sign PTC into law

*Threshold of 10 states reached and PT Compact Commission is formed

November 5: Inaugural meeting of the PT Compact Commission PTLC rules and bylaws finalized and passed

Compact Privileges issued

PTLC continues to add new members- target 53 jurisdictions!
