A Quick Guide to Informed Consent

✓ C – Communication

- Explain the intervention
- Use simple, non-technical language

O – Options

- Discuss alternative treatments
- Identify possible providers

✓ N – Necessary Disclosure

- Share benefits and risks
- Clarify expected outcomes

✓ S – Shared Decision-Making

- Confirm the patient/client's ability to decide
- Encourage questions and input

✓ E – Empower Autonomy

- Respect the right to accept or refuse care
- Consent can be modified or withdrawn at any time

✓ N – Nurture Trust

- Build a collaborative relationship
- Establish professional boundaries

✓ T – Transparency

- Document the consent process clearly
- Review expected timeframes and costs
